

CITY OF SCOTT CITY COVID-19 RESPONSE

- The City of Scott City has currently closed its lobby and will remain closed during the COVID-19 outbreak. The City Hall on drive -thru service will remain open and customers may continue to call in payments, use our ACH payment method, mail payments and continue to use the drop box located at City Hall. Meeting requests are cancelled without calling prior to make arrangements.
- The Scott City Police Department will continue to respond in person to the public for normal law enforcement related activities and lobby will be open to be able to access public postings.
- All public council meetings will be limited to the 10 or less gathering and 6 ft distance requirements. Council members will be able to attend council meetings virtually using media sources as to further prevent exposure. The public may all attend future council meetings via social media sources such as Facebook Live for viewing and hearing, during this time.

- Municipal court operations have been suspended through May 1st, 2020
- Community activities and events have been cancelled or rescheduled. The City's website and Facebook page will show the latest information.
- The city's kennel at this time will only be making emergency calls, in efforts to minimize contact for staff and the public.
- All City facilities are following best practices as recommended by health authorities, which includes frequent washing of hands, regular sanitizing of offices and equipment and limiting personnel when appropriate.
- The City is currently assessing other best practices and follow all guidelines set forth by our government leaders.
- The City has an Emergency Management Facebook page, which provides pertinent information and links as the situations change. Police Chief Michael Culler is the appointed Emergency Management Director.
